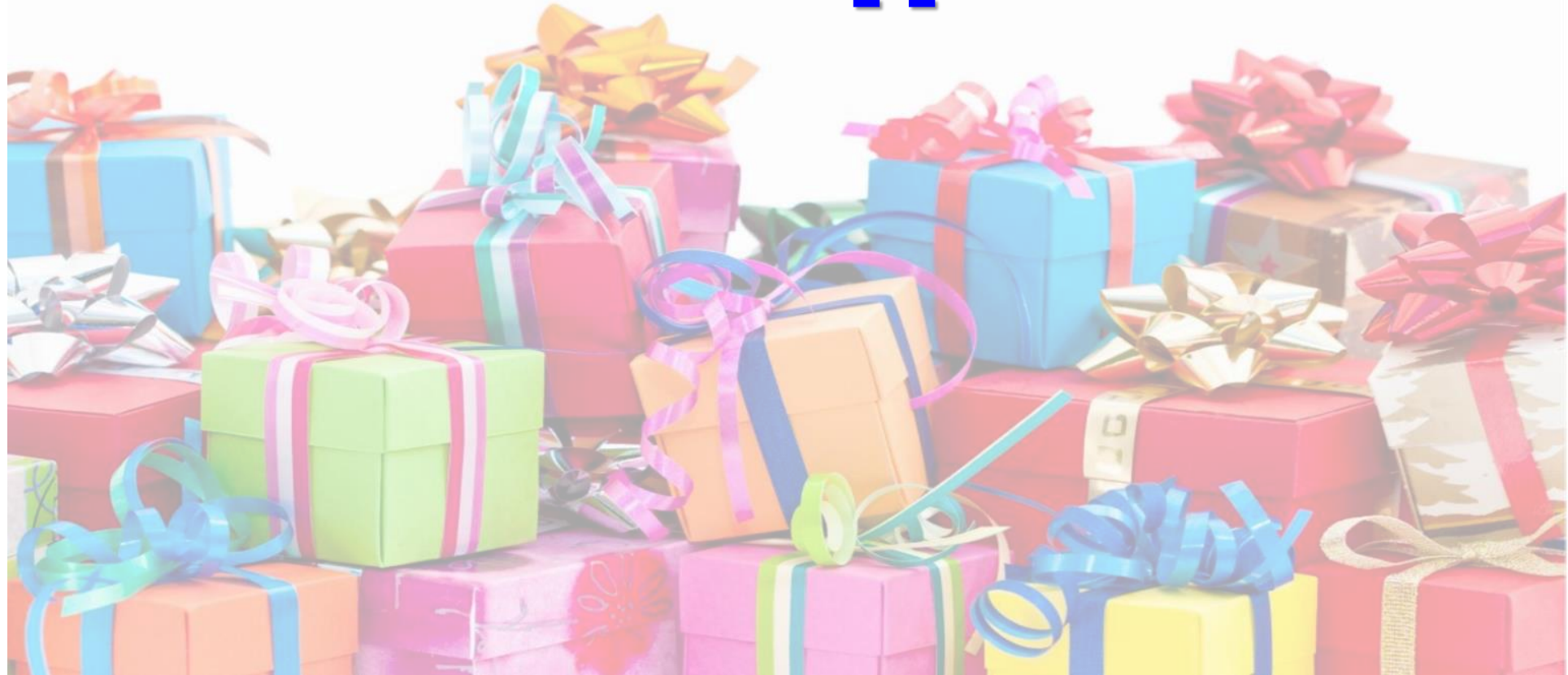

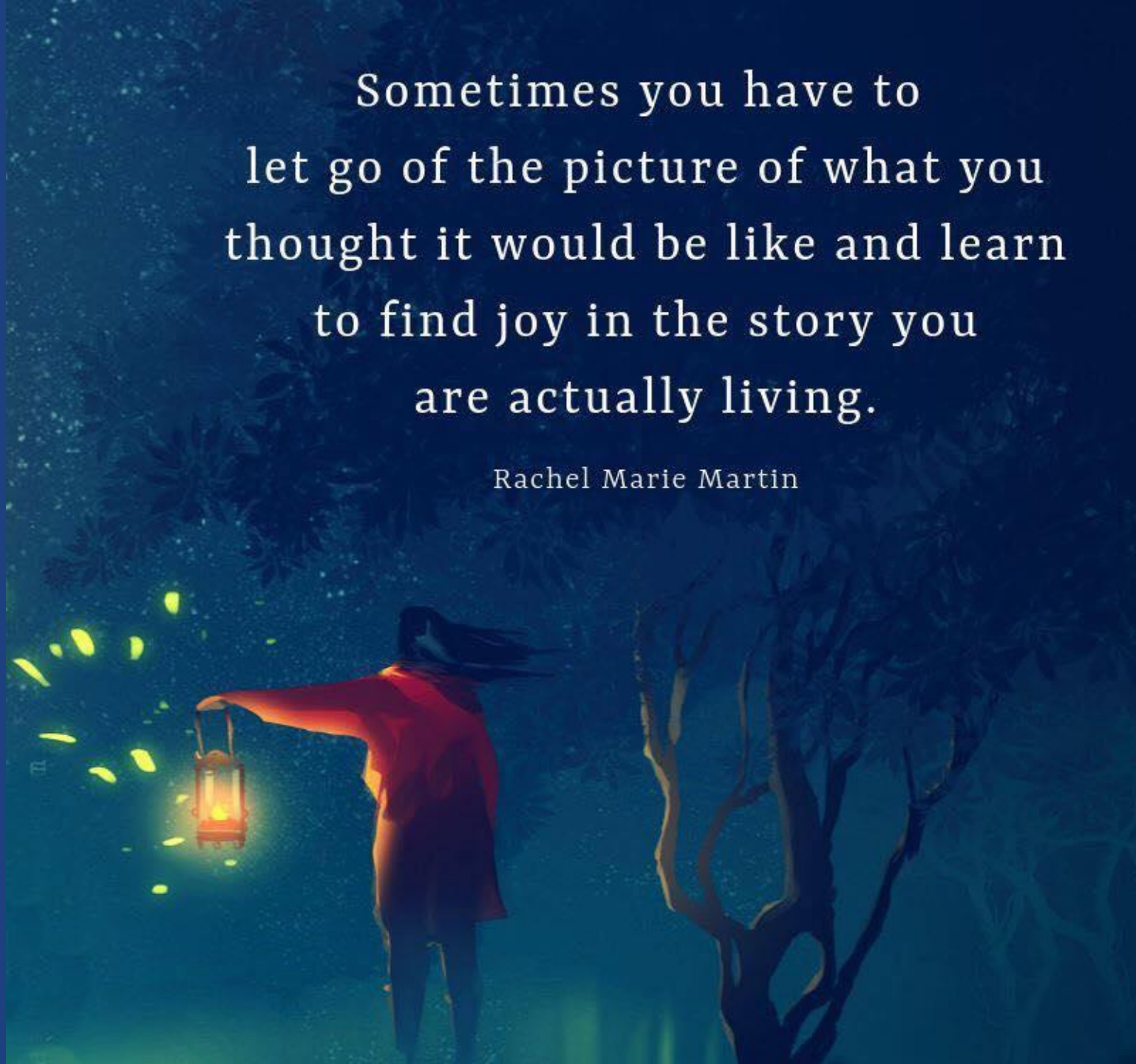


Name Tag Parking Lot

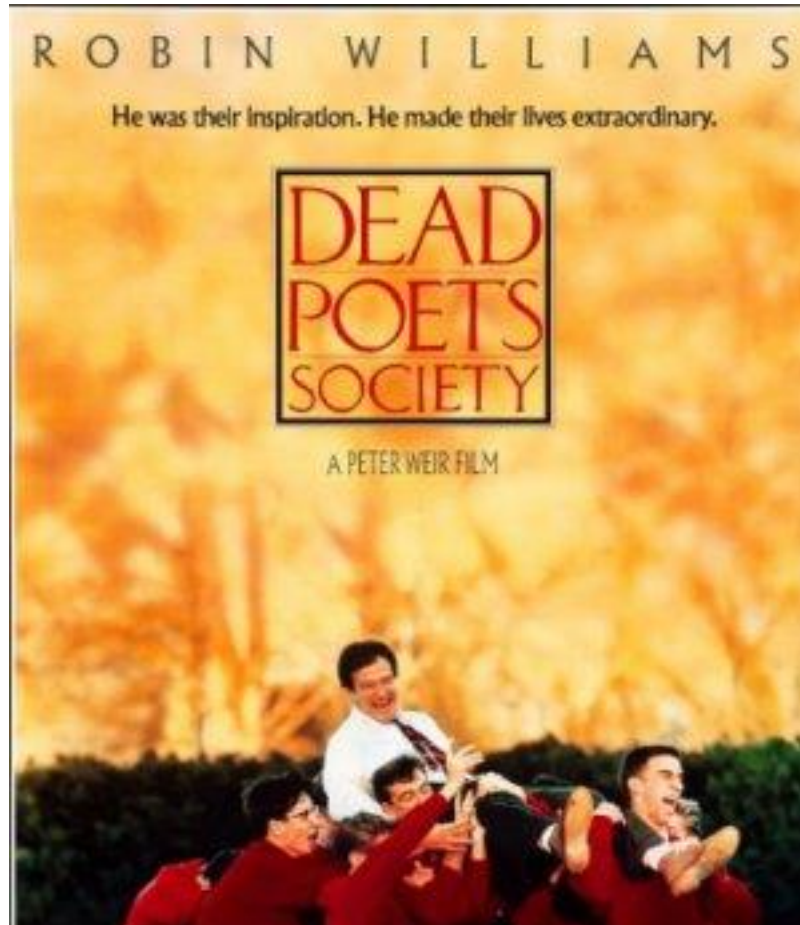

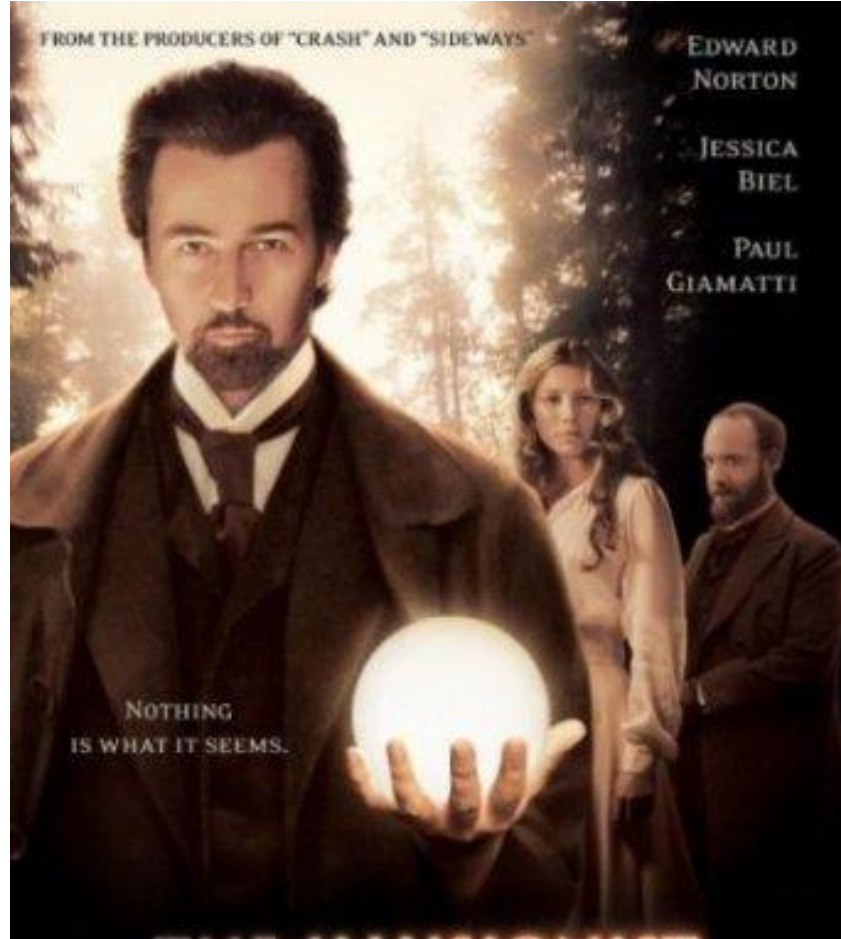
