The season of Lent is meant to prepare us for the coming celebration of Easter. It is a time for reflection, reconciliation, and renewal. While many give up something for the forty days of Lent, it can also be a time to add something to our spiritual life. It is a season for prayer, fasting, and giving. May we each make time for God and growth.

Warm greetings to you all at the House of Faith,

Leasing the Education Building is now official! It has been a big challenge both for Renu Hope and our church. To open a daycare center at our church, Renu Hope went through a multi-layered processes to secure approval from the State of California. But that is only half of the process. The Administrative Council, the Trustees, the District Superintendent, and the Building and Relocation Committee of the District all had to review and approve the lease. But God is faithful, and He has answered our prayers. My heartfelt thanks go to all of you for your prayers for this to happen.

Everything we need has been removed from the Education Building and relocated to various rooms in the Fellowship Hall. Except for office visits, most meetings and programs will now take place in the Fellowship Hall. Renu Hope will spend several months renovating the entire Education Building. The renovation includes installing new flooring, repainting the walls, adding new bathrooms in the basement, installing three new HVAC units, converting the storage space at the entrance of the office into a bathroom, and installing more security cameras and an alarm system.

I am especially happy that they will also be converting the courtyard between the Education Building and the Sanctuary into a playground. The old playground in the parking lot was in a bad shape and inconvenient for both children and parents. When we repaved the parking lot and removed the playground area, I told myself that a new one in the courtyard would be much better. Now, God is providing us with a new playground at no cost, in the exact location I had envisioned! Though we do not have any children in our congregation now, let us continue to pray that God will bring them to us in the future and that we can create a good space for them.

The lease will generate \$66,000 per year, which is more than \$10,000 higher than their initial proposal. We have been cleaning out the modulars in case Renu Hope wants to use the space in the future. One of the modulars was previously used to store clothes for a homeless support program that is no longer in operation. Debbie Wilson, director of Yucaipa/Calimesa Family Assistance, gratefully took all the clothing and supplies to her center. The modulars have the potential to generate an additional \$20,000 per year in revenue. The income from the lease will help pay our apportionments and rebuild the Foundation, which has been depleted over the years.

The broken heater in the Fellowship Hall is finally scheduled for repair, with improved functionality. We found a company that can repair our half-a-century old furnace. They will re-pipe and clean up the wiring, replace the pilot light with an electronic ignition, and install a new gas valve. This repair will extend the heater's lifespan by several decades.

Lent begins on March 5. This annual season serves as a time of spiritual retreat, rededication, and reflection on our faith, helping us strengthen our personal relationship with Jesus. We can observe Lent through fasting (which doesn't have to be food-related but can include abstaining from certain activities), praying, reading scripture, or engaging in other faith-strengthening practices. Perhaps you can do "walk and talk"—taking a walk for physical health while talking to God for spiritual renewal.

Ash Wednesday is March 5, and Maundy Thursday is April 7. We will hold worship services for both in the sanctuary at 7:00 PM. The Ecumenical service on Good Friday will be held at Green Valley Christian Church on the corner of Bryant and Date St. I will confirm this later. Easter Sunday is April 20.

Donations


