#### Behold the Hand

During Old Testament times, names among the Hebrew people signified more than mere identification; they were considered equal to the person himself. In this context, the name of God is the most holy and must not be taken in vain, as stated in the third commandment. Thus, the Hebrews could never vocalize God's name, YHWH (Yahweh or Jehovah), and instead referred to Him as "Hashem" (The Name) or "Adonai" (Lord). YHWH carries profound implications and theological significance, containing a hidden mystery of the Messiah. Y represents "yod," the tenth letter of the Hebrew alphabet, meaning hand or arm. H stands for "hey," the fifth letter, which means behold or look. W is for "waw" (or "vav"), the sixth letter that is shaped like a nail or hook, which is its meaning. Together, YHWH literally translates to "behold the hand and behold the nail." The Name of God reveals Jesus' redemptive work. On the evening of the first Easter, Jesus said to doubting Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands." The words and body language of the risen Christ point to the name YHWH. God, the lawgiver, established a new law of forgiveness on the cross and sealed it through His resurrection, ensuring it could never be revoked for all eternity. The Risen Christ invites all to examine His nail-pierced hand and believe.
