THE HOUR OF PRAYER

Peter and John were on their way to the Jerusalem temple for afternoon prayer, likely following the tradition of praying three times a day: morning, afternoon, and evening. At the Beautiful Gate, they encountered a man who had been lame from birth and was begging for help. Peter said to him, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."

Though many had passed by and given the man money, Peter looked beyond his immediate need. Moved by compassion and faith, he took the man by the hand and helped him to his feet; instantly, his feet and ankles became strong. He entered the temple walking, leaping, and praising God.

Peter's boldness flowed from faith strengthened by prayer. As a leader among the disciples and in the Jerusalem church, he bore the responsibility of caring for the early Christian community after Jesus' ascension. He did not pray merely out of habit or routine; he prayed because he continually needed God's intervention.

We may tell ourselves that we are too busy to pray even once a day. Yet the busier life becomes, the more we need to kneel. Praying three times a day is not excessive in light of the struggles we face, which is why the apostle Paul urges believers to pray without ceasing.
