The Path of Grace

The cup was a metaphor for someone's fate in the ancient Near East. King David famously confessed. "You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows," The cup here meant David's life in general. Kings hired cupbearers like Nehemiah to carry their cups for protection from assassination attempts by poison. The King's cup exemplified the throne. The cup of wine Jesus passed to his disciples during the Last Supper symbolized his whole being offered as a sacrifice. In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus prayed that his cup be removed. What kind of cups do we carry? Our cup usually feels half-full or even empty, no matter how hard we try. For example, people spend years laying the foundation for their life through education. After that, the average person spends over 40 years until retirement. But years of education and labor do not always guarantee a good retirement. Blood, sweat, and tears are still insufficient for our happiness. David's cup was really no different than ours. So what was the secret behind David's confession? God filled his cup to the brim that he did not lack in anything. God's action to fill and overflow our cup is called grace. Despite our incompetence and tendency for failure, God's grace has led us this far and will lead us home.
