GUIDED BY THE SPIRIT

Every move Jesus made was intentional. On one occasion, Jesus was on his way to the Gadarenes and ordered the disciples to cross the Sea of Galilee by boat; the account makes it clear who set the day's itinerary. Then a scribe approached Jesus and said, "Teacher, I will follow you wherever you go, but first let me go and bury my father." As a scribe, he was well-versed in the law and likely believed his response was thoughtful and responsible, yet he did not recognize the contradiction in his words. To follow Jesus was not merely to offer lip service, but to submit to him as Master and "what Jesus says, he will do and where he sends, he will go." The scribe still wanted to retain control over the direction of his life.

Once we decide to follow Jesus, we no longer insist on choosing our own path. Jesus is the pilot of the boat on our Galilee journey and we are the passengers; we look to him for direction and do not fear the storm because he is able to calm it. This is the Spirit-guided life Paul described: "We don't owe this old do-it-yourself life one red cent. There's nothing in it for us. The best thing to do is give it a decent burial and get on with your new life. God's Spirit beckons. There are things to do and places to go!" (Romans 8:12-14, The Message)
