A Life Transforming Touch

A large crowd had gathered around Jesus, pressing in so tightly that they almost crushed him. Among the crowd was a woman who had been suffering from bleeding for twelve years. She came up from behind and touched the edge of Jesus' cloak, and immediately, her bleeding stopped. Jesus sensed that power had gone out from him and asked who had touched him. Trembling, the woman stepped forward and admitted that she was the one who had touched him and had been healed.

This story highlights significant aspects of faith. The woman's condition represents our own hopeless situations — problems that only Jesus can truly heal. We may seek help from many sources, but only Jesus holds the lifeline to save us from our troubles. The crowd had heard of Jesus' miracles and followed him closely. However, simply knowing about Jesus or being near him was not enough. The woman stood out because she made a personal connection by reaching out to him in faith and entrusting her life to him. Being born into a Christian family, having Christian friends, or attending church does not automatically make us believers. It is our personal commitment to Jesus that truly defines our faith. At the very moment we reach out to Jesus, Jesus comes into our hearts through his Spirit, making his presence real
in our lives.
