#### **Discerning Eyes**

Philip was one of the first disciples called by Jesus at the beginning of his public ministry. Few people knew about Jesus at that time. Philip eagerly told Nathanael that he had found Jesus of Nazareth, the one mentioned by Moses and the prophets. Nathanael bluntly replied, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" Nazareth is situated in a small basin surrounded by hills. Accessibility was poor, and several hundred impoverished residents relied solely on agriculture for their livelihood, and Nathanael's skepticism revealed how the public looked down on the village. But the village's obscurity benefited Jesus until he started his ministry. Soon after meeting Jesus, Nathanael declared, "You are the Son of God; you are the King of Israel." Nathanael was radically transformed and became a devoted follower. Nathanael's distinct reactions before and after encountering Jesus clearly highlight two opposite perspectives. When something bad happens. we are tempted to dive into negativity and say, "This is a complete disaster. I don't see anything good coming from it." Alternatively, we may look at it with discerning eyes and say, "Jesus is my sovereign Lord. There must be God's will in this." God often allows unwelcome events to redirect us, preventing greater turmoil and drawing us closer to Him.
