The Ultimate Reality

We live in the presence of God every day. Whether we recognize it or not. God is ever-watchful. Nothing escapes his notice; he looks into our hearts and understands exactly what we conceal within. God is never deceived. As stated in Hebrews 4:13 (NIV), "Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give an account." Religious leaders like the Pharisees failed to acknowledge this and became hypocrites. God showed Ezekiel an example of this in a vision (Ezekiel 8). The priests had erected an idol of jealousy in the court of the Jerusalem temple. They had made a hidden wall on which they drew all kinds of images of idols. They appeared to have gone into the temple to worship God, but in actuality, they were worshiping idols, thinking "The Lord does not see us" (Ezekiel 8:12). Consequently, their utterly detestable practices drove God far away from the temple. It caused him to send the Babylonians to destroy the temple in 586 BC. God is the ultimate reality that no one can deny or escape. But we often seek to display our virtue before others, even when it takes covering up other things. We tend to focus on "what people will think of me", instead of "what will God think of me." Let us not waste time trying to white-wash ourselves, but be honest before God.
