Aging with Grace

In Psalm 71, King David praved about his old age, saving. "Do not cast me away when I am old: do not forsake me when my strength is gone." David was the greatest ruler Israel has ever known. He was a prolific poet, a skilled musician, and a brave warrior from a young age. He united all twelve tribes, subdued neighboring countries, and expanded the nation's territory. He conquered Jerusalem, brought the Ark of the Covenant there, made it the capital city, and prepared everything to build the glorious temple; the list goes on. No king of Israel comes close to David in terms of heroic achievements. However, this great king witnessed his body decaying and his capabilities dwindling. as the Psalm alludes to his aging. He could no longer serve God and country as he once did in his youth and feared losing God's favor. God allowed David to rule Israel for forty years despite his concerns about aging. He died at a good old age, enjoying a long life filled with wealth and honor (I Chronicles 29). His last words indicated that God had granted him every desire (II Samuel 23). Aging is nothing to be depressed about. We may grow older physically, but God sustains us and provides the strength to continue serving Him until our last breath.
